# DESIGN STORY

"Every time you sit down, it feels like sinking into gentle dunes."

## Inspiration:

The shell's design draws from the natural curves of wind-sculpted desert dunes—the smooth slope on the windward side and the steep arc on the leeward side—creating a dual-curved structure that ergonomically supports the body. Its unique matte texture mimics the flow of sand grains, offering a subtle granular sensation to the touch, as if brushing against the very skin of a desert.







## Design for Longevity

Sustainability starts with reduction. Our “one shell, multiple uses” modular system allows you to update function simply by changing the base—dramatically extending the life of the core shell and reducing waste from the start.



## Design for Recyclability

Made from reinforced polypropylene (PP) with a tool-free design. Created for easier future sorting and recycling—right from the source.

## Dining Area | A Social Hub of Flexibility and Order

Flexibility and order coexist here. The uniform four-legged chairs easily group around round tables, accommodating both group meals and casual conversation spots. Their lightweight design allows for easy movement and cleaning, creating a relaxed yet organized social.







## Stacking

With just a gentle lift, 10 chairs transform into a sleek vertical tower – maximizing space while maintaining elegant order.



## Felt Pads

Woven from delicate fibers, they provide hushed protection – each movement as gentle as a cloud grazing the ground.





## Auditorium | A Shared Space for Focus and Immersion

Order and concentration converge here. Sled-base chairs are arranged in uniform rows, their curved bases offering steady, silent support for prolonged sitting. A consistent design language eliminates visual distraction, directing every gaze forward and immersing every thought in collective engagement.

## Dining Area | A Social Hub That Works

Two heights of bar stools with matching high tables define two zones in one space. The higher seats are for conversation and breaks, the lower ones support focused, short-term work. One unified design accommodates both leisure and concentration—turning the dining area into a true "third space."



## Quick Collaboration Zone | An Energy Hub for Spontaneous Creation

No reservations needed—ideas collide here anytime. Sled chairs and bar stools gather freely around a high table, instantly forming an ad-hoc meeting spot that can assemble or disperse in moments. This is an on-the-fly brainstorming station, a rapid screen-sharing corner—where discussions emerge in the flow, and collaboration takes shape exactly when it's needed.



Inspiration from formal meetings continues to grow and evolve here. This corner, defined by a high table and whiteboard, is designed for impromptu discussion and visual thinking. The bar stools support a relaxed posture whether standing or seated, making it easy to write, post, and reorganize ideas in real time. Here, conversation flows freely, unbound by time or agenda, deepening as it moves.




