Emotionally speaking, the space needs to offer comfort while also inspiring creativity and innovation.

To realize this vision, we require a modular furniture system. Built upon a unified design language as its genetic core, it can effortlessly adapt to various teaching and learning modes through simple reconfiguration. This approach guarantees both the visual cohesion of the space and empowers every corner with the specific, personalized functionality it requires.



DESIGN STORY

"Every time you sit down, it feels like sinking into gentle dunes."

Inspiration:

The shell's design draws from the natural curves of wind-sculpted desert dunes—the smooth slope on the windward side and the steep arc on the leeward side—creating a dual-curved structure that ergonomically supports the body. Its unique matte texture mimics the flow of sand grains, offering a subtle granular sensation to the touch, as if brushing against the very skin of a desert.







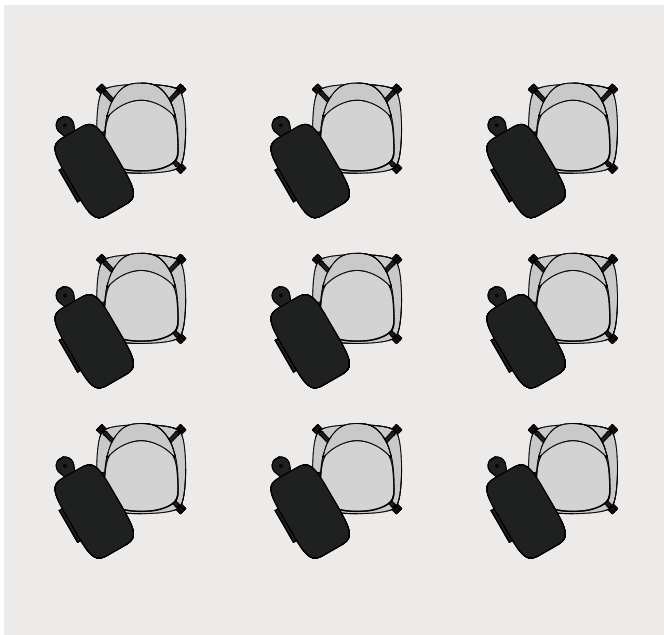

A Tech-Integrated Zone for Focus and Connection



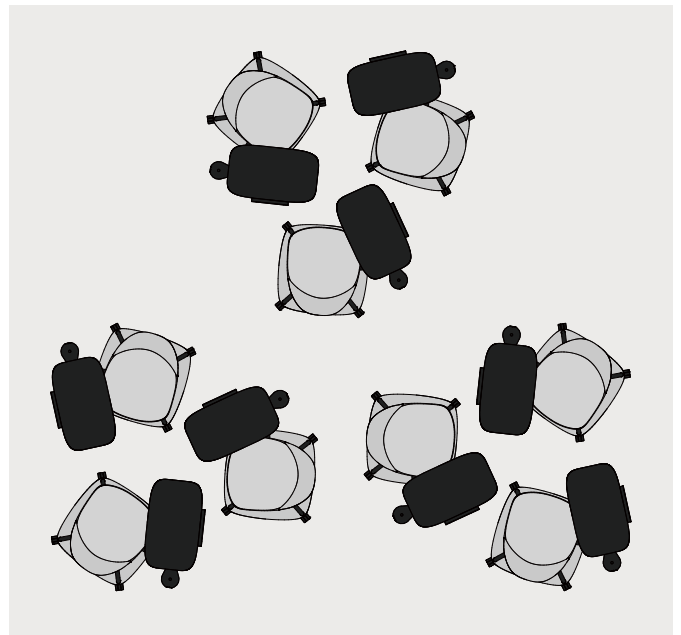
Bookbag Rack with Worksurface: Chair Shell Lo01/Lo03 /Lo04 + Frame_ K47 + Bookbag Rack_P27

The uniform tablet chairs provide a dedicated surface for notes and deep thought, with widened tops that easily accommodate books or tablets. Their easy-swivel design allows the classroom to transform instantly from orderly rows into interactive discussion circles. Within a traditional layout, these chairs spark active participation, enabling heuristic teaching to flow naturally.

Cup Holder

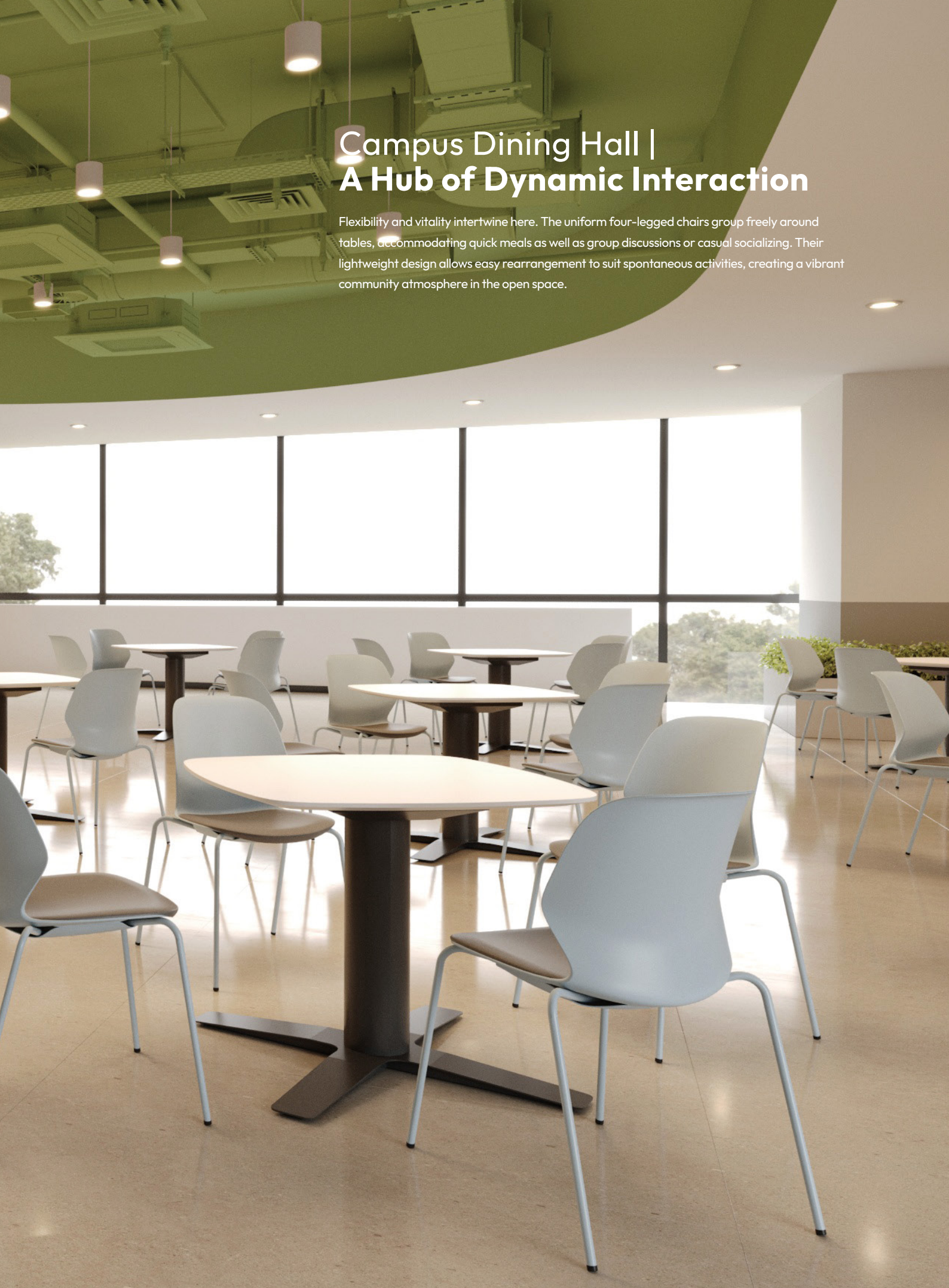
The optional cup holder swivels under the desk panel when not in use.

In fixed-layout classrooms, order and focus form the foundation of learning. The uniform four-legged chairs provide steady support, while their clean lines and orderly arrangement reinforce a sense of structure. The linear layout ensures clear sightlines, minimizing distractions and naturally directing attention to the front of the class—creating a pure, efficient environment for knowledge transfer.





School Lecture Hall | **A Flexible Space for Academic Focus**

The sled-base chair features a unique curved design that ensures silent, stable performance in lecture halls. The arched base maintains balance during leaning movements, eliminating disruptive noise. Its ground-hugging profile saves space while simplifying cleaning. When arranged in orderly rows, it creates a formal academic atmosphere, while providing ergonomic support for individual use.





Library | **A Silent Foundation for Focus**

True silence begins with stable seating. The four-legged chair's multi-directional glides intelligently adapt to subtle floor imperfections, automatically leveling themselves. Every movement is silent and rock-steady, providing reliable, undisturbed support for deep focus.

Vitality and diversity flourish here. Two heights of bar stools with matching tables naturally define distinct functional zones. A unified design language maintains visual coherence while enabling seamless transitions between different modes of use, creating a vibrant campus community atmosphere.





Corridor Huddle Nook | **A Quiet Hub for Casual Connection**

Can be flexibly arranged anywhere in campus corridors to create intimate gathering spaces. Two upholstery options are available: fully upholstered for ergonomic support and lasting comfort, and seat-only upholstery for minimalist style and easy maintenance. Paired with simple fixed tables, the layout blends naturally with pedestrian flow without disrupting access. Perfect for casual chats, one-on-one conversations and small group discussions, turning corridors into elegant quiet zones for relaxed communication.

Low-back height-adjustable bar stools adapt to diverse resting postures and form independent leisure corners with standard high tables; the seat height can be adjusted freely to meet the needs of tea breaks, interval relaxation and casual communication between teachers and students. With a sleek minimalist appearance, stable silent movement and easy daily maintenance, it builds a soothing, relaxing and healing buffer rest space amid the busy campus circulation.
